The Edmund Fitzgerald

Seventy years after the legendary storm of 1905, another ship was claimed by a November gale. On November 9, 1975, the 729-foot ore freighter *Edmund Fitzgerald* left Superior, Wisconsin, passing Split Rock on its course along the North Shore to Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan. The following evening the ship went down in heavy weather northeast of Whitefish Point. All 29 men aboard were lost.
